**Format:** 90 minutes + 30 seconds per move from move one to the end of the game (Fischer).

**Default/Forfeit Time:** 30 minute forfeit time from start of each round.

**Half Point bye Policy:** Players can take a maximum of 2 ½ points in the first 5 rounds.

A half point bye must be declared before the commencement of the previous round

## Conditions of Entry:

- 1) All players must be members of Chess Association of Qld
- 2) Unrated players are only eligible for the Unrated Group prize. There are no tie breaks for any of the prizes
- 3) **Foreign players without a FIDE id number will not be accepted. Foreign players will need to obtain a FIDE id number from their National Federation and advise that number prior to their entry being accepted.**

**Australian Citizens & Permanent residents without FIDE id numbers will need to provide a date of birth prior to the start of the event or their entry will not be accepted.**
